- Parents are invited to participate in this event. The Highlands PTO will provide coffee, juice and pastries for adult participants in the PTO room at Highlands starting at 8:00 am.
- If you live outside the 2-mile walking radius from school, parents may drop student off at one of the gathering spots to participate in the walk to school.
- Special incentives (while supply lasts) given to walkers crossing at the crossing guard points and those that ride their bicycle!

#### ROUTES TO SCHOOL AND MEETING LOCATIONS:

##### Leaving at 7:20 am from:

#8- 1.1 mile-Across from Gepettos Pizza at the corner of Long Reach Dr and Lexington Blvd– **Rivercrest, Lion's Head and Fairmont apartments as well as those on Sunset Trail in the Highlands.** Walk along Long Reach Drive in the neighborhood, turn right at The Highlands Drive then right on Williams Trace to the crossing guard at Edgewater.

#4 .89 mile- Near the fire station at the corner of Honey Creek Drive and Settlers way for those in the **Gables Edgewater apartments, Old Mill Park and Creekshire neighborhoods-** Cross Settlers Way at Honey Creek; walk along Settlers Way, then turn left and continue along Edgewater to turn right on Waters View then an immediate left on Serene Oak to school. - join in if you live in **Edgewater Bay** as the group passes your neighborhood!

##### Leaving at 7:30 am from:

#9- .74 mile-Englewood neighborhood entrance at the corner of Englewood Drive and Williams Trace – **Englewood Place-** Walk down Williams Trace, cross Lexington at the signal light to crossing guard at Edgewater and Williams Trace

#2- .74 mile- Entrance of Oyster Point neighborhood- corner of Oyster Point and Lexington for **Oyster Point-** Walk along Lexington to the crossing guard at Colonist Park Dr & Lexington; then cross the street and continue down Colonist Park Drive to school

#3 .61 mile-corner of Pecan Point Drive and Settlers Way Blvd. for those in the **north part of Creekshire** and the **east portion of the Highlands-** Walk across Settlers Way, then walk along Pecan Point to turn left on Colonist Park to school- join as we go past your house or street!

#7 .51 mile- Highlands pool parking lot at the corner of the The Highlands Drive and Williams Trace - We will continue down Williams Trace to the crossing guard at Edgewater- join if you live in the **Highlands.** *\*\*\*this is the best location for joining the walk if you live more than 2 miles from school!*

##### Leaving at 7:40 am from:

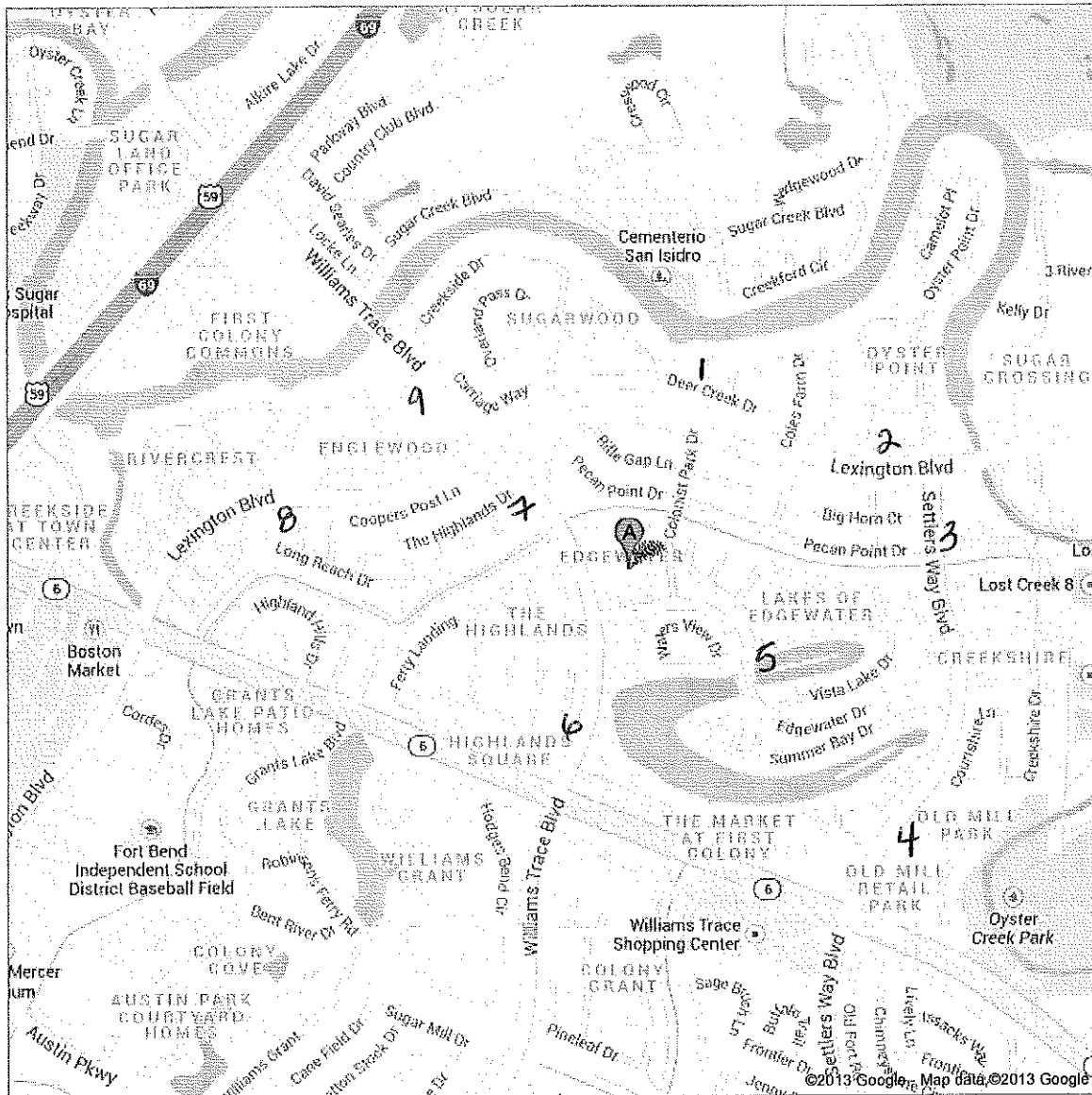
#5 0.3 mile- The green space next to the lake on Edgewater and Waters View- Walk down Serene Oak to school. Join in if you live in **Lakes of Edgewater or Edgewater Gardens.** *\*\*\*this is a good location for joining the walk if you live more than 2 miles from school!*

#6 .47 mile- behind Corelli's at the corner of Quarry Hill and Williams Trace- Walk along Williams Trace to the crossing guard - join in if you live in the **Highlands near Highway 6**

#1- 0.43 mile- near the Sugar Wood pool at the corner of Colonist Park and Lexington Meeting spot for SugarWood; Walk down Colonist Park- join in if you live in **The Highlands on Rifle Gap, Pecan Point, Brushy Creek or The Highlands Drive on the east side of Williams Trace.** *\*\*\*this is a good location for joining the walk if live more than 2 miles from school!*
